Comments on Association Activities, if any:

- During 2014 APDPE has continued with its usual activities, including the Monthly e-Newsletter and Monthly "Encuentros", as reported in 2014. Also, during 2014 it took place the course at El Escorial (Universidad Complutense de Madrid), having as panellists weel-known journalists, lawyers and judges.
- APDPE continues with its agreements with the universities of Madrid and Salamanca, and still proving the professors for the studies of Private Investigation. University of Madrid has also delegated in APDPE the program and organization of the 3rd year of studies (final one). Seville University has discontinued the studies on Private Investigation.
- Our yearly conference and AGM took place in Toledo, with a great attendance and success. Main subject of the conference was, obviously, the new Law on private investigation (actually Law 5/2014 on Private Security). Members of the special Police (and Guardia Civil) unit on Private Security, judges, lawyers and private detectives analyzed as panellists the new law.
- APDPE has attended IKD meeting in 2014, in Paris. APDPE delegate, David Sanmartin, was asked to do a presentation on the Spanish regulation on Private Detectives and Private Investigation at the SNARP conference.
- APDPE still being the legal representative of Spanish private detectives nation-wide, as member at the National Commission on Private Security, a public entity that joins the Spanish Government and the major associations on Private Security. The aim of this entity is to analyze the regulation and its enforcement and to suggest amendments and to inform about new projects of regulation.

Comments on Regulation, if any:

As said, in 2014 the Spanish Parliament approved a new law on Private Security, including the regulation of Private Detectives and Private Investigation.



Following to the new law, Spanish government has to isuue a new development regulation. The deadline is April 2015 and we suspect this deadline is not to be attended. In June 2014, APDPE filed at the Spanish Ministry of Interior (Home Office) a proposal of regulation on those matters related to Private Investigation and according to the general provisions of Law 5/2014. We expect that most of our proposal will be included at the final regulation.
