Comments on Regulation:	Although included in The Private Security Industry Act 2001 the licensing of investigations has yet to be implemented and is not currently to be in the foreseeable future

>Association Description:

The Association of British Investigators is the longest established organisation representing professional Investigators in the UK with its foundations laid way back in 1913. With the absence of any statutory control of the investigation industry in the UK, The Association recognised the need for self-regulation many years ago and set very high standards to meet the criteria for membership opting for quality rather than quantity. Members are admitted only after stringent vetting. Members must conduct their business in a professional manner, with Professional Indemnity Insurance and by complying with a strict code of ethics with disciplinary procedures in place to monitor any transgressors. Members are also required to provide a Criminal Convictions Certificate no older than 3 years. A Governing Council normally consisting of up to 10 members including the President and the Chairman, oversees the administration of The Association, which is conducted day to day by the Secretariat team from the offices in Elstree. The Governing Council officers are democratically elected by the membership each year at an annual conference. The Association is recognized and supported by The Law Society of England & Wales, The Association is also the only sector accredited association with The Law Society of Scotland and the government body, the Drivers and Vehicle Licensing Agency giving members exclusive access to the vehicle keepers' database electronically in certain circumstances. Private Investigation as an activity is included in the process of regulation under the Private Security Act 2001 but has yet to be implemented.

>Association Activities:

The ABI is working with the data protection supervisery body on a UK GDPR Code of Conduct, which if approved is expected to have wide reaching influence on the structure of the sector and help in the protection of the public against the bad practice by rogue agencies.
